STATEMENT OF CLAIM

The Plaintiff's claim is for:

- a) A declaration that the various transactions identified by the receiver, and variously described in the Statement of Claim, resulting in the Unlawful Loans, the Unlawful Advances, and the acquisition of assets in the names of shareholders, their related interests and/or persons related to the shareholders, are unlawful;
- b) A declaration that the 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th and 17th Defendants have breached their duties as directors of uniBank Ghana Limited, and are liable for all the loss to uniBank Ghana Ltd occasioned by their acts of breach:
- c) A declaration that the 1st, 2nd, 4th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th and 17th Defendants are jointly and severally liable for the repayment of the amount of GHS 5,712,623,145 to uniBank Ghana Ltd;
- d) A declaration that the assets mentioned in paragraphs 31 and 32 of the Statement of Claim, as well as all other assets identified in this matter to have been acquired with the funds unlawfully taken of uniBank Ghana Ltd, and within the possession or control of any of the Defendants, are held in trust for uniBank Ghana Ltd;
- e) An order directing the Defendants to return and/or transfer all the assets mentioned in paragraphs 31 and 32 of the Statement of Claim, as well as all other assets identified in this matter to have been acquired with the funds unlawfully taken from uniBank Ghana Ltd to the Plaintiff;
- f) An order directing the Defendants to account to the Plaintiff for all advantages, benefits, gains and profits, derived from or obtained by virtue of assets referred to under relief (e);

- g) Against the 1st, 2nd, 4th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th and 17th Defendants, an order for the recovery of the remainder of the amount of GHS 5,712,623,145 unlawfully taken from uniBank Ghana Limited, after the deduction of the amount used to acquire the assets which are transferred and/or returned to the Plaintiff under relief (e) together with commercial interest; and
- h) Costs (including legal fees) on a full-indemnity basis; and
- i) Any further orders that the Honourable Court may deem just.

- 5. An order appointing the Registrar and/or any other officer of the Honourable Court as receiver and manager of the Assets, pending the final determination of the action; and
- 6. An order permitting the duly appointed receiver and manager to appoint and/or engage any individual(s) or entity(ies) they consider qualified to assist them in the execution of their duties as receiver and manager of the Assets.
